

PRIVACY POLICY

NextGenOne Foundation llc., a 503c chapter non-for-profit organization of RS Cares Foundation Inc. (“NextGenOne”, “us”, or “we”) provides an intermediary technology platform located at www.nextgen.one (“Platform” or “Site”) for prospective investors to independently search and invest in securities offerings on the Site. As explained below, we collect information from users (“you”, “your”, or “User”) in various ways when you interact with our Site. By using our Site, you consent to our collection and use of information as explained in this Privacy Notice and agree to be bound by our Terms of Use.

Collection of Information

Non-personally Identifiable information

NextGenOne collects non-personally identifiable information from you regarding your usage of our Site (“Non-Personally Identifiable Information”). Non-Personally Identifiable Information may include, without limitation:

- Site pages viewed, websites visited before visiting the Site, frequency of visits, clickstream data, browser type, operating system, organization name, internet connection speed, presentations and videos viewed, time spent viewing pages of our Site or using certain features of our Site, demographic data such as server locations, clickstream data, location services, server location, cookies existing on your computer, search criteria used and results, date and time of access or visits to our Site, frequency of visits to our Site, connection speed, browser web storage or application data caches and other information which does not specifically identify you.

We collect this information using various technologies (some of which are described below), including, but not limited to, cookies, web beacons, web session variables, server log files, clear gifs, browser plug-ins or add-ons, or Javascript.

- “Cookies” are pieces of information that may be placed on your computer by a Site for the purpose of facilitating and enhancing your communication and interaction with that Site.
- A “web beacon” is typically a transparent graphic image (usually 1 pixel x 1 pixel) that is placed on a website or in an email which allows a website to record the simple actions of the User opening the page that contains the beacon.
- “Server logs” can be either a single log file or several log files automatically created and maintained by a server of activity performed by the server, which can include information about any transaction you conduct with the server.

Please note that we also use “Google Analytics” tools. Google Analytics collects information including, but not limited to, the time of each of your visits to the Site, whether you have visited the Site before, what website referred you to the Site, and what pages you viewed on the Site.

Personally Identifiable Information

NextGenOne also collects personal information from you (“Personally Identifiable Information”) when you sign up for an account, send us an email through the Site, sign up for or purchase a service through the Site, or make an investment through the Site.

Personally Identifiable Information refers to non-public information that personally relates to or directly or indirectly identifies you (such as your name, password, age and date of birth, gender, email address, postal mailing address, home/mobile telephone number and/or taxpayer identification number, Internet protocol (“IP”) address, investment objectives, investment experience, assets and income, and other similar information, or other information you provide or upload to the Site such as photographs, answers to questionnaires or surveys, or responses filled in on blank forms by you made available on the Site).

We request that you provide us with the following personal information:

- Identifying information such as your name, addresses, telephone numbers or email addresses when you register for an account with us
- Your demographic information;
- Your phone number, billing, postal and any other relevant information;
- Your citizenship;
- Your Identification document information;
- Your Ethereum address;
- Your personal or company social media profile;
- Your financial information in connection with verification or transaction procedures;
- Information that you provide to us through a web form, by updating or including additional information, through your participation in the creation of the site content, communications with other users, chats, or when you contact with us regarding our Services;
- Additional information we are required or authorized by applicable national laws to collect and process in order to authenticate or identify you or to verify the information we have collected

Please note that we do not collect any other types of information, including special personal data, which is data that includes details about your race or ethnicity, religious or philosophical beliefs, sex life, sexual orientation, political opinions, trade union membership, information about your health and genetic and biometric data.

To keep your Personally Identifiable Information accurate, complete, and current, please contact us with any changes, and we will take reasonable steps to update or correct the information in our possession that you have previously provided.

Use of Information

Your Site experiences

NextGenOne will use information you provide consistent with this Privacy Policy. NextGenOne will use information you provide to us, including Non-Personally Identifiable Information or Personally Identifiable Information, to better serve you and enhance your experience with the Site, among other things. This may include having to modify or copy such Non-Personally Identifiable Information or Personally Identifiable Information, or other information such as images or textual content you provide, in order to provide you with a seamless and enjoyable experience.

Promotional Use

NextGenOne may use Non-Personally Identifiable Information and Personally Identifiable Information unless you ask us otherwise: (1) to market our products and services to you; (2) to provide services and products requested by you; (3) to serve advertisements on our Site; (4) to enable our vendors and contractors to provide and assist us in the marketing, operation, troubleshooting and analysis of our Site and other services; (5) to analyze data to send more targeted messages to you or other Users of our Site; (6) to conduct research and analyze data to improve our products, services, and Site; (7) to deliver email messages like special offers, updates, newsletters, customer service, and service announcements.

Our legal and contractual obligations

NextGenOne may use Non-Personally Identifiable Information and Personally Identifiable Information (1) to verify User information when you intend to use our Services; (2) to comply with and meet any regulatory requirements for the offer or sale of securities required by law, rules or regulations to our affiliates or members; (3) to protect our Site or its Users; (4) to engage in any other lawful activities we believe are consistent with the foregoing; and (5) when required by law or to protect against legal liability.

Please note that we may provide any of the abovementioned services through third parties enlisted in this Privacy Policy.

Information available to other users

NextGenOne may make your information, including Non-Personally Identifiable Information or Personally Identifiable Information, available on its Site and visible to other Users of or visitors to the Site. For instance, subject to certain preferences and permissions as to visibility you will be allowed to make, information you provide about yourself in response to questionnaires on our Site may be made available to others such as information concerning your status as an accredited investor. As such, other Users of our Site may be able to personally identify you based on your information made available on our Site. As a further example, if you utilize Third Party Services to log into our Site, other Users to whom you may be connected to through such Third Party Service may be able to view or follow information about you, including Non-Personally Identifiable Information or Personally Identifiable Information, on our Site.

Third parties service providers

NextGenOne may employ or contract other third parties, companies, or individuals to perform certain functions or services on its behalf in relation to Services provided to you. Examples of these services from such third parties, companies, or individuals, may include:

- ID verification, electronic document signing, payment storing and processing, sending postal mail and e-mail, escrow services, disbursement of funds, analyzing data, providing marketing assistance, and providing customer service.

As such, these third parties, companies, or individuals have access to only those pieces of your information, including Non-Personally Identifiable Information or Personally Identifiable

Information, which are needed to perform their functions or services, and may not use it for other purposes.

Security

NextGenOne may also use and disclose Personally Identifiable Information and Non-Personally Identifiable Information to help us to carry out certain internal functions such as information management, account processing, client services, or other data collection relevant to our business; to investigate and help prevent potentially unlawful activity or activities that threaten the integrity of our Site or network; to protect and defend our rights or property or the rights or property of others; as required by courts or administrative agencies; and in connection with a financing, sale, merger, or reorganization of NextGenOne's business or assets. Any successor in interest to our business would acquire the information we maintain, including Personally Identifiable Information, and may alter the terms of this Privacy Notice.

Except as identified here and subject to user's ability to opt-out as provided by Regulation S-P, NextGenOne does not and will not sell any of your information, including Non-Personally Identifiable Information or Personally Identifiable Information, to any third party for purposes of advertising, soliciting, or telemarketing.

NextGenOne may be required to disclose your information, including Non-Personally Identifiable Information or Personally Identifiable Information, to other companies or entities in the event that NextGenOne may be sold or is sold to another company or entity. In that case, your information, including Non-Personally Identifiable Information or Personally Identifiable Information, may be sold or transferred to such acquiring company or entity. Please note that you will be notified prior to such selling or transfer of our company.

Third Party Sites and Services

The Site contains links to other websites and services **not maintained by NextGenOne**. In addition, other websites and services may also reference or link to the Site. We encourage you to be aware when you enter or leave our Site, or surf the Internet, and to read the privacy statements of each website and service that you visit. We do not endorse, screen, or approve, and are not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of, other websites or services.

Messaging

The Site permits Users to communicate with companies and other Users posting information on the Site. We may read, collect and analyze information transmitted between Users for regulatory compliance and marketing purposes. We do not guarantee that information provided by Site visitors or investors is accurate or complete. NextGenOne assumes no liability or responsibility for any errors or omissions in the content of its Site.

Your Rights

We may at times send you e-mail communications with information, marketing or promotional materials in case you agree to such communication while providing us with your email address. If you prefer not to receive such e-mails from us, you may **opt-out** (unsubscribe completely) by

contacting us through the contact form www.NextGen.One.com/contact, chat feature, or by submitting a question through the imbedded “help” button that is processed through Zendesk.

Please note that opt-out requests may take up to five (5) business days to process. Please also note that at times we may need to send you e-mail communications that are transactional in nature such as service or termination announcements or payment confirmations which are communications you will not be able to opt-out of.

You will be able to modify the information concerning your account by visiting your profile page and editing any information you wish to change. You will be able to view and change your e-mail address, password, financial information, contact information, or other login information by visiting your account’s settings page subject to our Site policy. If you wish to suspend your account or need help modifying account information, please contact us through the contact form [link?], chat feature, or by submitting a question through the imbedded “help” button that is processed through Zendesk. We may require up to five business days to process such requests.

Through your account settings you will be able to set certain preferences and permissions regarding the visibility of your information, including Non-Personally Identifiable Information or Personally Identifiable Information, to other users. You may stop or restrict the placement of NextGenOne’s cookies, Google’s cookies and third party cookies on your computer by adjusting your web browser preferences or a “Do Not Track” setting in your web browser. If you do so, you may still use our Site, but this may interfere with some of its functionality. You may also clear cookies from your computer via your web browser settings.

If you would like us to remove your Personally Identifiable Information from our database, please send a request through the contact form [add hyperlink], chat feature, or by submitting a question through the imbedded “help” button that is processed through Zendesk.

Please note that directly contacting us you may also exercise the following rights:

- The right to request a copy of all Personally Identifiable information we hold about you;
- To request that your Personally Identifiable information is erased where it is no longer necessary;
- To withdraw your consent to the processing of your Personally Identifiable information at any time.

These processes may take up to several business days to process.

Security

We use all appropriate reasonable efforts to secure access to Personally Identifiable Information in our possession. These include, but are not limited to, internal reviews of: (a) the Company’s data collection; (b) storage and processing practices; (c) electronic security measures; and (d) physical security measures to guard against unauthorized access to systems where the Company stores Personal Information.. Unfortunately, no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be secure. As a result, while we are committed to protecting your Personally Identifiable Information, we cannot the complete ensure or warrant the security of any information you provide to us.

We protect the security of your information during transmission by using Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) software, which encrypts information you input. Wherever appropriate, we obfuscate and/or encrypt information in our systems and/or during information transfer.

We utilize third party service providers who may store on their servers addresses, financial information, electronic signatures, and payment information. In accordance with their contractual obligations with us, obligations under applicable laws and their own privacy policies such third party service providers are required to use all appropriate reasonable efforts to secure access to Personally Identifiable Information. These third parties to whom we may disclose personal information have their own privacy policies that describe how they use and disclose personal information. Those policies will govern use, handling and disclosure of your personal information once we have shared it with those third parties as described in this Privacy Policy. It is important for you to protect against unauthorized access to your password and to your computer. Be sure to log off when finished using a shared computer.

Children's Privacy Policy

The Site is not intended for use by children, especially those under eighteen years of age. No one under eighteen years of age is allowed to use the Site, provide any personal information or receive our email distributions. We do not knowingly solicit or collect Personally Identifiable Information from children under the age of thirteen (13) or anyone under eighteen years of age. Applicable Law and Jurisdiction

The Site is maintained in the United States of America. By accessing the Site, you consent to and authorize the export of Personally Identifiable Information to the United States of America and its storage and use as specified in this Privacy Notice.

This Privacy Notice shall be governed by, construed and entered in accordance with the laws of the State of California applicable to contracts deemed to be made within such state, without regard to choice of law or conflict of law provisions thereof. All disputes with respect to this Privacy Notice shall be brought and heard either in the shall be brought and heard either in the California state courts located in Los Angeles, California, or the federal district court of California located in Los Angeles County, California. You consent to the in person jurisdiction and venue of such courts. YOU HEREBY WAIVE YOUR RIGHT TO A TRIAL BY JURY WITH RESPECT TO ANY

CLAIM, ACTION OR PROCEEDING, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, ARISING OUT OF, OR RELATING TO, THIS AGREEMENT TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.
